#### REGION FOCUS IN 2018

#### RESEARCH (Largest area of investment)

We have invested more than \$4.6 billion in research since 1946. To accelerate progress against cancer, we will double our annual research investment to \$250 million a year by 2021.

#### COLORECTAL CANCER

We will continue to build on the momentum and successes of the 80% by 2018 campaign to ensure we hit the 80% screening target for all adults in every community.

#### HPV

Our Mission: HPV Cancer Free public health campaign will reach an 80% vaccination rate nationally by 2026 to help eliminate HPV-related cancers.

#### **ACCESS TO CARE**

We believe no one should die of cancer because they cannot get the quality care they need. We are working to increase screening and reduce cancer risk for underserved communities and boost our investment in our transportation and lodging programs to help patients receive treatment and support.

#### TOBACCO

We aim to eliminate consumption of all combustible tobacco through policies and public health interventions. We are also working to accelerate adoption of 100% tobacco-free policies on college campuses.

#### LUNG CANCER

We will address risk reduction, screening, access to treatment, stigma, survivorship, and research to fuel a rapid reduction in lung cancer mortality rates.

#### **BREAST CANCER**

We are working to ensure women in underserved communities, who bear an unequal burden of cancer, have access to high-quality screening and timely follow-up care.
